- Microsoft Sharepoint Server multiple versions and platforms
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2022 versions 17.12.9, 17.8.22, 17.10.16, and 17.14.5
- Microsoft Word 2016
- Nuance Digital Engagement Platform
- Remote Desktop client for Windows Desktop
- Windows 10 multiple versions and platforms
- Windows 11 multiple versions and platforms
- Windows App Client for Windows Desktop
- Windows Server multiple versions and platforms
