AMD published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following products on February 10, 2026. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- AMD Athlon and AMD Ryzen Processors – multiple models and versions
- AMD Graphic Drivers – multiple models and versions
- AMD µProf performance analysis tool-suite – versions prior to 5.2.431
- AMD Vivado Design Suite installation – versions prior to 2025.2
- AMD Documentation Navigator installation – tool being retired
- AMD EPYC and AMD EPYC Embedded Series Processors – multiple models and versions
