Google Chrome published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following product on March 31, 2026. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your product is always updated.

- Stable Channel Chrome for Desktop – versions prior to 146.0.7680.177/178 (Windows/Mac) and 146.0.7680.177 (Linux)

Google is aware that an exploit for CVE-2026-5281 exists in the wild

Update 1

On April 1, 2026, Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) added CVE-2026-5281 to their Known Exploited Vulnerabilities (KEV) Database.
