

## ADV2025\_451 TeamViewer Security Advisory (December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025)

TeamViewer has published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following products on December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- TeamViewer DEX Client NomadBranch.exe versions prior to 1E Client 25.11.0.29
- TeamViewer DEX Client NomadBranch.exe versions prior to 1E Client 25.9.0.46 -HF-PLTPKG-524 (Hotfix)
- TeamViewer DEX Client NomadBranch.exe versions prior to 1E Client 25.5.0.53 -HF-PLTPKG-526 (Hotfix)
- TeamViewer DEX Client NomadBranch.exe versions prior to 1E Client 24.5.0.69 HF-PLTPKG-525 (Hotfix)
- TeamViewer DEX multiple versions
