

## ADV2026\_175 Apple Security Advisory (March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026)

Apple published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in multiple products on July 29, 2025. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- iOS and iPadOS – versions prior to 18.6
- iPadOS – versions prior to 17.7.9
- macOS Sequoia – versions prior to 15.6
- macOS Sonoma – versions prior to 14.7.7
- macOS Ventura – versions prior to 13.7.7
- tvOS – versions prior to 18.6
- visionOS – versions prior to 2.6
- watchOS – versions prior to 11.6

### Update 1

Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) added CVE-2025-31277 to their Known Exploited Vulnerabilities (KEV) Database on March 20, 2026.
