



## ADV2026\_129 VMware Security Advisory (March 4th, 2026)

VMware published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following products on February 24, 2026. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

### Update 1

On March 3, 2026, Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) added CVE-2026-22719 to their Known Exploited Vulnerabilities (KEV) Database.

- VMware Cloud Foundation – versions prior to 9.0.2.0
- VMware vSphere Foundation – versions prior to 9.0.2.0
- VMware Aria Operations – versions prior to 8.18.6
