



## ADV2026\_152 Palo Alto Networks Security Advisory (12<sup>th</sup>, March 2026)

Palo Alto Networks published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following product on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- Cortex XDR Broker VM 30.0.0 – versions prior to 30.0.49
- Cortex XDR Agent 8.7-CE – versions prior to 8.7.101-CE on macOS
- Cortex XDR Agent 8.3-CE – versions prior to 8.3.102-CE on macOS
- Prisma Browser – versions prior to 145.7.9.76
