Apple has published a security advisory addressing vulnerabilities in several products on December 12th, 2025. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- iOS – versions prior to 26.2
- iPadOS – versions prior to 26.2
- iOS – versions prior to 18.7.3
- iPadOS – versions prior to 18.7.3
- macOS Tahoe – versions prior to 26.2
- macOS Sequoia – versions prior to 15.7.3
- macOS Sonoma – versions prior to 14.8.3
- tvOS – versions prior to 26.2
- watchOS – versions prior to 26.2
- visionOS – versions prior to 26.2
- Safari – versions prior to 26.2

Apple is aware that **CVE-2025-14174** and **CVE-2025-43529** are being exploited.

On December 12, 2025, the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) included CVE-2025-14174 in its Known Exploited Vulnerabilities (KEV) catalogue, followed by the addition of CVE-2025-43529 on December 15, 2025.
