OpenSSL published a security advisory highlighting vulnerabilities in the following products on April 7, 2026. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions by ensuring your products are always updated.

- OpenSSL - versions 3.6.0 to versions prior to 3.6.2
- OpenSSL - versions 3.5.0 to versions prior to 3.5.6
- OpenSSL - versions 3.4.0 to versions prior to 3.4.5
- OpenSSL - versions 3.3.0 to versions prior to 3.3.7
- OpenSSL - versions 3.0.0 to versions prior to 3.0.20
