Apple has published a security advisory to address vulnerabilities affecting the following products on March 7, 2024. It is recommended that you take the necessary precautions to ensure your products are always protected.

- macOS Monterey – versions prior to 12.7.4
- macOS Sonoma – versions prior to 14.4
- macOS Ventura – versions prior to 13.6.5
- Safari – versions prior to 17.4
- tvOS – versions prior to 17.4
- visionOS – versions prior to 1.1
- watchOS – versions prior to 10.4
